**Notes:**

(a) Reported here are the U.S. and foreign institutions that had the largest numbers of graduates on the Yale faculty. Complete degree data for only 565 faculty members were available for this table. There were no data available on the undergraduate degrees of 190 faculty members, nor on the doctoral degrees of 5 faculty members. If a faculty member has two undergraduate or doctoral degrees from the institutions listed here, and one of them is from Yale, it has been counted as a Yale degree. "Tenured Faculty" includes all Professors and tenured Associate Professors; "Non-Tenured Faculty" includes all term Associate Professors and Assistant Professors. "Total Number of Degrees Earned" could include two degrees for a person who earned degrees at both the undergraduate and doctoral levels. "Number of Faculty Receiving Those Degrees" is the unduplicated count of the number of faculty who earned those degrees.
