Notes:

- (a) The Peking University-Yale University Joint Undergraduate Program was established in 2006 and students were enrolled for the first time in the Fall of 2006. The program was discontinued Fall 2012.
- (b) Fall 2011 total enrollment for the special degree Eli Whitney program excludes two students who are counted in the enrollment for the Peking University-Yale University Joint Undergraduate Program.
- (c) Totals include 5th and 6th year students registered in "less than half time" status, "in absentia paying tuition" and special students. Students on leave of absence and students registered as "dissertation submission" are excluded.
- (d) Enrollment figures for each school include only those students paying tuition to that school in the Fall term. Enrollment also includes students registered as "non-degree special" and, beginning Fall 2005, "in absentia paying tuition" students are also included. "Leave of absence" students are excluded. Beginning Fall 2005, visiting scholars are not included in the Law School enrollments.
- (e) Fall 2005 enrollment includes 24 students displaced by Hurricane Katrina: Yale College 11; GSAS 6; Drama 2; Law 2; Epidemiology & Public Health 3.

Source: Prior to 2005-06 data for the graduate and professional schools was collected from the school registrars. Beginning Fall 2005 all student counts and undergraduate categories are based on IPEDS Fall Enrollment Survey. "New Transfers In" is a category reported in the IPEDS Fall Enrollment Survey beginning Fall 2007. In prior years, new transfers were included in the total undergraduate counts and not broken out separately.
