Notes:

- (a) Each student, whether full-time or part-time, is counted as one student in this table. Counts for the Graduate School exclude students on leave of absence and students registered as "dissertation submission." The professional school counts exclude students on leave of absence. The enrollment figures for each school include only those students paying tuition to that school in the Fall term.
- (b) Beginning Fall 2010, the increase in "In Absentia" students is due to a Graduate school change in policy regarding how students admitted to candidacy are coded for registration purposes.
- (c) Effective Fall 2003, the D.F.E.S. degree program has merged with the Ph.D. program in Forestry.
- (d) Beginning Fall 2005, visiting scholars in the Yale Law School are no longer included in the enrollments.
- (e) Beginning Fall 2012, the School of Management enrolled students for the first time in the new Master of Advanced Management program.
- (f) Students admitted for the first time to the Global Health International Visiting Student Elective Program.
- (g) Bachelor of Arts/Master of Music (BA/MM) students are not included in enrollment totals. Prior to Fall 2014, all students in the D.M.A. program are "non-resident" students enrolled less than half-time and, with the exception of 2005-06, are not counted as enrolled and listed in brackets for information only. Beginning Fall 2014, a new D.M.A. "resident" program was established and students are included in the total enrollment for the School of Music.
- (h) Effective Fall 2006, the D.N.Sc. program will be phased out and a new Ph.D. program in Nursing will be offered. Current students may remain in the program to complete their degree or transfer to the Ph.D. program. All new students will be admitted to the Ph.D. program. Beginning Fall 2012, students were enrolled in the new Doctor of Nursing Practice program.
- (i) As a result of Hurricane Katrina, 24 displaced students were enrolled in Yale schools for the Fall 2005 semester. These "special" students were enrolled in the following schools:
Yale College - 11; Graduate School of Arts & Sciences - 6; Drama School - 2; Law School - 2; School of Medicine, Epidemiology & Public Health - 3.
- (j) The Artist Diploma is a non-degree program which began enrolling students in Fall, 1991. Beginning Fall, 1993, they are included in the enrollment totals for the School of Music.
- (k) Beginning Fall 2018, the School of Management enrolled students in a new Masters of Management Sciences program (MMS)
