- (a) This table includes **all** degrees, certificates and diplomas awarded for the period July 1 through June 30 of each academic year.
- (b) The number of Terminal Master's degrees includes Graduate School students only. Yale College students earning the simultaneous BA/MA or BS/MS degree included.
- (c) Students studying in the Institute of Sacred Music are awarded their degrees by the Divinity School or the School of Music. The counts for the Institute of Sacred Music are included in the totals above and are shown in italics for information only.
- (d) Beginning Fall 2003, the Doctor of Forestry (D.F.E.S.) program was merged with the Ph.D. program. Students are no longer admitted to the Doctor of Forestry program and degrees reported here represent students who were already enrolled in the program prior to its termination.
- (e) The Master of Advanced Management program was offered for the first time in Fall 2012.
- (f) M.D. students may declare their participation in the Global Medicine program at any time prior to the fall of the academic year of graduation from medical school. Award of the certificate is contingent upon completion of the degree program at the School of Medicine.
- (g) In January 2006 the Yale Corporation approved establishment of the joint M.D./Master of Health Science degree for students completing a competitively funded full fifth year of research and other requirements.
- (h) The M.H.S. degree is also awarded to students in the Robert Wood Johnson Clinical Scholars Program and to fellows and faculty of approved departments and programs.
- (i) Beginning Fall 2006, the Doctor of Nursing Science program is being phased out and will be replaced by a Ph.D. program in Nursing. Effective Fall 2012, students were enrolled in the new Doctor of Nursing Practice program
