3. "Ladder/Continuing" category counts ladder faculty in the professional schools who are not on the tenure track, including ladder faculty in Medicine and Nursing whose tracks do not confer tenure.
4. "Instructional" includes all non-ladder appointments, such as lector, lecturer, acting instructor, critic, visiting critic, emeritus faculty, professor of the practice, and non-ladder clinician.
5. "Research" includes all types of research appointments, such as senior research scientist, associate in research, research associate, visiting research scientist/scholar, and professor adjunct of research.
6. "Visitor/Instructional" includes all non-research categories of visiting faculty, such as visiting professor, visiting associate professor, visiting assistant professor, and visiting lecturer
7. "Visitor/Research" includes all visiting researcher ranks.
. The School of Drama does not confer tenure; counts of tenured faculty in Drama refer to the Dean of the School.
8. "Yale Appointees, non-Employees" counts voluntary faculty and others who hold a faculty appointment but are not paid by Yale
9. The School of Music does not confer tenure; counts of tenured faculty in Music refer to faculty with fully-joint appointments in other schools.
